Dear praying friends,

Greetings from Kumasi. It has been some time since we have communicated with you, and many things have happened since our last letter. First of all, our friends the Sommer family returned to Kumasi in May. It has been wonderful to have them back with us again. We have thoroughly enjoyed rekindling our friendship with them and fellowshiping as much as our schedules will allow.

Once the Sommers returned, the time came for the Aaron family to leave and begin their year of furlough. We are thankful that they are safely in the United States and have had the opportunity to reunite with friends and family. They are currently traveling and reporting to their supporting churches. Their departure signaled the time of our transition from Biblical Baptist Church in Atonsu to the Bible study in Bokro. We are now ministering in Bokro full-time. We are continuing to reach out into the community with the Gospel and working to teach and disciple the new believers we have. There are two men in particular that I would ask your prayers for. Their names are Ahmed and Benjamin. They have both recently become born again. We are now teaching them about scriptural baptism and church membership. Ahmed has already expressed a desire to become a pastor and we rejoice in that. I have already explained to him that he first must be baptized and become a member of the Lord's church. He and Benjamin are both confused about what baptism truly is because of all the lies told by the false churches here in Ghana. This is a very common problem. We want to take our time and teach them fully, allowing the Holy Spirit to move in their hearts and reveal the truth to them.

In our last letter, we mentioned the fact that we were searching for a bigger vehicle for our growing family. After searching for some time, God led us to the right one. He also provided all the necessary finances through our home church and several of our supporting churches! We were able to purchase a 2011 Hyundai Santa Fe. It is in very good condition with only about 37,000 miles on it at the time of the purchase. One of the biggest blessings is that it has seven seats. It gives us all the room we need in a smaller vehicle that will use far less fuel than the bigger alternatives. It has been such a blessing to us already. Thank you so much to every church and individual who gave so that this could be possible. You will never know how much you have helped us.

Lastly, many of you have been made aware that Kelly gave birth to our fifth child on July the 9th. If you have not heard before this letter, we now have our first little girl! Her name is Rebecca Lynn. She is healthy and growing too quickly already. Her brothers adore her and my wife tells me I am totally smitten. Thank you to all who were praying for the health of Kelly and Rebecca through all of this. Kelly contracted malaria toward the end of the pregnancy but was able to receive adequate treatment quickly and recovered in plenty of time before delivery. Other than that there have been absolutely no issues with health. God has been so good to us. We are truly blessed beyond measure. God bless you all as you labor for Him wherever it is that He has placed you.
